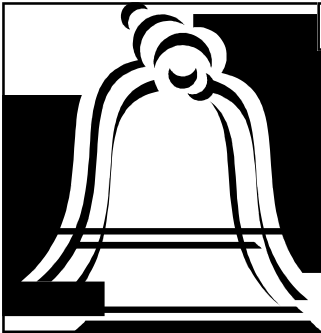

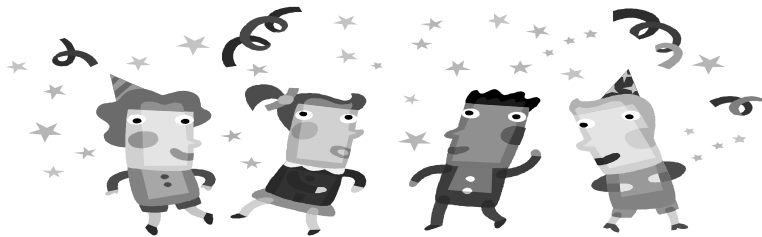

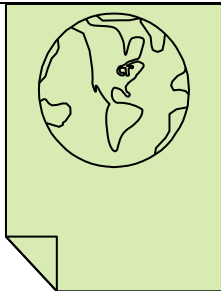
Words from the Pastor



Every one of us shares the need for security. That fact was captured in comic form by Charles Schultz in his comic strip Peanuts. Schultz pictured one of the characters, Linus, tenaciously clinging to his security blanket. Wherever he goes or whatever he does, Linus must have his blanket. He feels insecure without it. This may be humorous, but all of us who have had children, or can remember our own childhood, know the importance of that security blanket. In fact, if we are honest, even as adults, we still need a "security blanket" of one kind or another.

We need a place where we can find warmth and love, a gracious spirit and generous attitude, and the delight in each other's company. As Christians, we profess a belief that the church, as the body of Christ, is called to be a place of such "blessed fellowship."
